As well as maintaining contact with all patients, and looking after their journey's, Emily also will be looking into ways of improving areas of service for patients and colleagues.

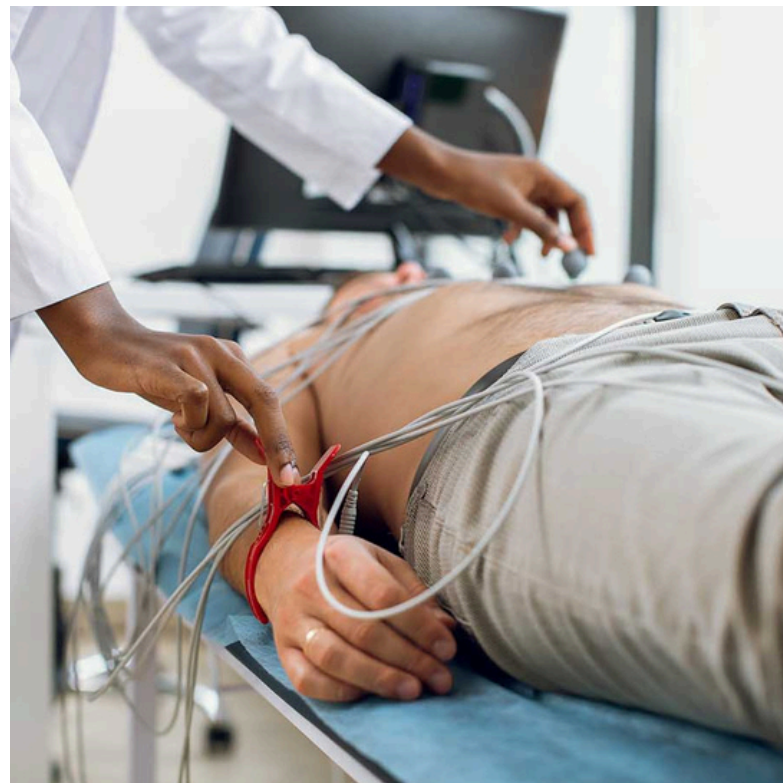


New Service Men's Health Assessments

Our men's health assessments aim to detect common medical conditions such as glucose spikes (indicative of excessive weight gain and potential pre-diabetic or insulin-resistant states), cardiovascular diseases, and prostate cancer. The main goals are accurate diagnosis and effective prevention through education, lifestyle changes, and evidence-based medical interventions when needed.

Our men's health clinics have been designed in partnership with the prostate centre and are run by specialist nurse practitioners, supervised by expert consultants, and offer cutting-edge technology, including smartphone apps for real-time health monitoring.

Fast-track, one-stop-shop pathways provide immediate access to diagnostic tests such as virtual coronary angiography and CaRi Heart scores, which are highly accurate for early detection of coronary heart disease.

Metabolic Health Assessment

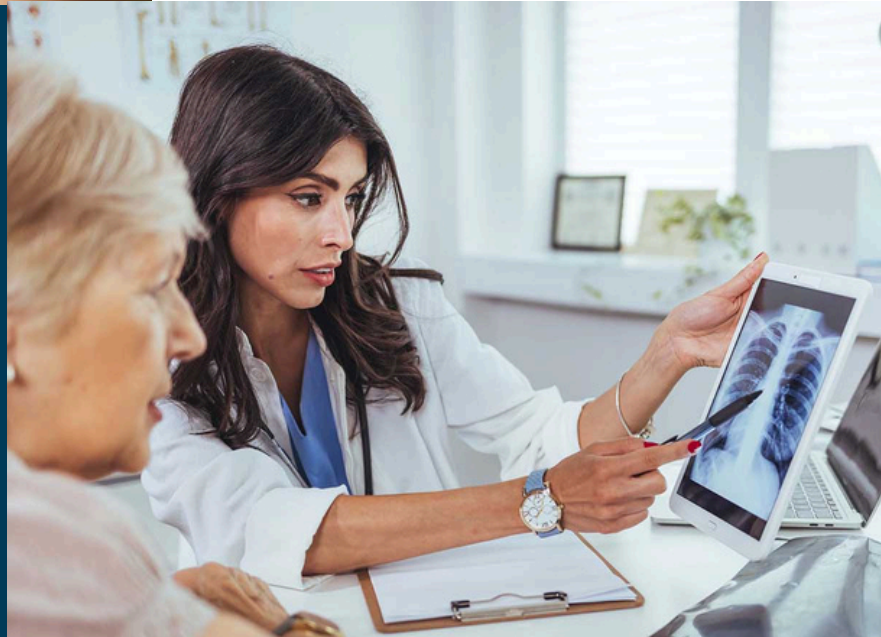
There is increasing awareness that modern lifestyles, processed food and even healthy diets including fruit may be damaging us from an early age by causing glucose spikes or highs. Latest research indicates glucose spikes contribute to systemic inflammation, believed to be contributing to many health conditions, including coronary artery disease.

Our Metabolic Health Screen provides a comprehensive assessment of an individual patient's metabolism, including glucose variability, as well as traditional measures of inflammation and glucose homeostasis.

X-ray

We can offer scans for those in need each Wednesday and Thursday, and available for walk-ins. Specialising in chest X-rays, for symptomatic patients, and as a part of a routine MRI workup for patients with pacemakers.

We also offer a direct access referral system for local colleagues and GPs, who can refer their patients to us for same week X-ray scanning.
